**MOVE-UP REGULATIONS:** Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the trial secretary only. Move-ups for Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> must be received not later than 6:00 p.m. on Monday January 23<sup>rd</sup>. **MEASURING:** Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in. Instead, please fill out the section at the top of the entry form. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

**WAIT LIST:** This club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the January 11<sup>th</sup> closing date. A maximum of 20 *entries* (not dogs) will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and time of January 11<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 p.m. Any entries withdrawn by January 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00 p.m. will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list and into the trial will receive a full refund.

**ENTRY:** Entry fee is \$23 for the first entry, \$15 for the second entry of the same dog, per day. Mail entries, maximum of 10 per envelope, with fees payable to GABOC, to Beth Elliott, 9N909 Koshare Trail, Elgin, IL, 60124. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries will be returned in their entirety. Express mail entries must waive the signature requirement, or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms, and the correct entry fee. Please do not use staples to attach checks and/or height cards to your entry! Checks returned due to non sufficient funds will be assessed a \$25 fee. All illegible or incomplete forms, or those with insufficient entry fees, will be returned, no attempts by email or phone will be made!

Notification of receipt of entry will be emailed to all exhibitors providing an email address. A second notice will be sent after the draw with the dog's entry status. Any exhibitor that does not have an email address should send a SASE or postcard to be returned after the draw with their entry status information. No other acknowledgment of entry status will be given! Trial secretary is not responsible for emails returned due to illegible email addresses, full mailboxes, spam blockers or any other event causing email to be returned or missed, and no further effort will be made. If you have recently changed your email address and think that I may have the old one on file, please highlight or otherwise draw attention to the new address!!!

Final entry confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter 1, Section 18 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors providing a working email address will be emailed their confirmations, all other exhibitors will be sent their confirmations via the US Postal Service.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:** This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

**PRIZES AND AWARDS:** Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Any team earning their MACH or PAX title will receive a jump bar and rosette. New title ribbons will be available. All participants will receive a toy, regardless of whether or not they qualify. No awards will be mailed.

**MEASURING:** Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in. Instead, please fill out the section at the top of the entry form. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

**CLASSES:** All Standard and Jumpers classes will be offered. There will be no FAST, ISC or non-regular classes at this trial.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS:** Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Bitches who come into season or any dog sustaining an injury after the closing date may have their entry fee returned, less an administrative fee, by providing the trial secretary with a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour before judging begins.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging, however handlers arriving after the scheduled course walk through for their class has taken place are not guaranteed a chance to walk the course. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Conflicts between rings should be discussed with the judge prior to the start of the class and the gate steward notified.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up areas. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors are required by DuPage County and the state of Illinois to maintain proof of either rabies vaccination or titer.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

**SITE INFORMATION:** The agility trial will be held at Car-Dun-Al's training facility, 10783 Wolf Drive, Huntley, IL. The training center is in the southwest corner of the second building on the right. It will be indoors on ¾ agility matting. There will be no barking dogs allowed in vehicles, they must be crated inside. Fast food restaurants are nearby. Any additional questions regarding the site and its amenities should be directed to the trial chairman.

Directions to the site are as follows:

From the east, take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 approximately 3.7 miles to Oakcrest Drive and turn right (known as Algonquin Road to the right). Go less than .1 miles on Oakcrest to Wolf Drive and turn left.

From the west, take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Road. Turn right on Harmony Road and drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Road. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right (Main Street). Drive 1.4 miles on Main Street to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Oakcrest Drive and turn left. (Algonquin Road to the right). Drive approximately .1 miles to Wolf Drive and turn left.

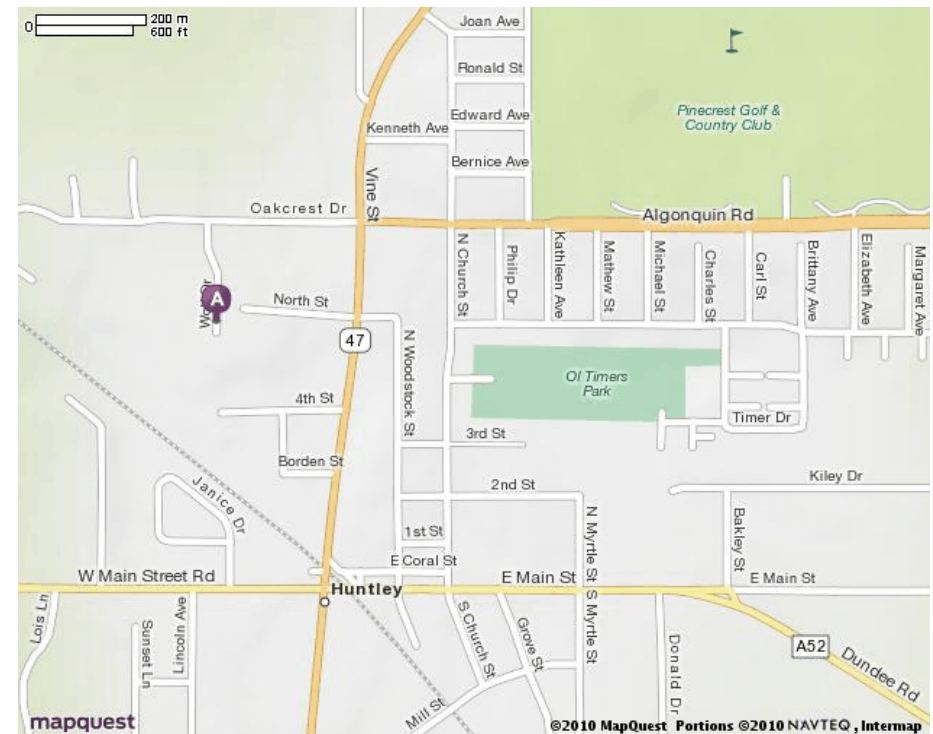

## INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative or a Volunteer Measuring Official prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010 These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776.
